VLSI-SoC 2024

The 32th VLSI-SOC conference from October 6 to 9, 2024, was co-sponsored by IFIP, IEEE CEDA, IEEE CASS, TU Delft, Region Tanger, Cadence, CNRST Universitè Abdelmalk Essaadi.

Its venue was Tanger, Morocco in presence.

The Conference was organized and chaired by Said HAmdioui, TU Delft, NL, and Anass El Haddadi, ENSA, Morocco. The Program co-chairs were Dr. Elena Ioana Vatajelu, TIMA Grenoble, France, and Prof. Hussam Amrouch, TUM, Germany.

There were 3 keynotes, 6 regular sessions, 4 special sessions, 2 embedded tutorials, 2panel sessions, 1 industrial session, 2 poster sessions, and 1 PhD forum. 60 persons participated to the embedded tutorials.

The conference had 102 valid submissions, with 79 regular papers, 3 industrial contributions, 5 proposals for special sessions, 2 embedded tutorials and 14 contributions to PhD and Student forum. Acceptance rate: 31% (25 oral presentations) + 21 posters.

5 – Other initiatives and discussions

The WG members discussed membership rules: after two years of inactivity, the WG chair will contact members via email to assess their interest and availability to continue participating in the WG.

The WG considered organizing an annual advanced school for young professionals focused on topics relevant to the WG. The first edition is scheduled for **September 1–6, 2025**, on **Favignana Island, Italy**. IFIP sponsorship was discussed but not finalized due to time constraints. Regardless, this inaugural event will serve as the foundation for establishing a recurring school with IFIP support starting in 2026.

The WG identified issues regarding the organization of funding to support PhD students and students from emerging countries attending **VLSI-SOC**, which should be clarified for future editions.
